From LONDON & THE SOUTH

Travelling towards Norwich on the A11, when you reach Norwich Thicket roundabout take the exit onto Newmarket Road (A11). You will then need to stay on this road until you reach the roundabout where it meets the A140.

Take the first exit (signposted Airport) on to Mile End Road, get into the right hand lane and watch out for the speed camera here!

At the next set of traffic lights, turn right onto Unthank Road, go through the 20 miles per hour zone and you will arrive at a double roundabout, where you want to take the second exit each time.

Follow this road down to the bottom of the hill and this will take you round to the left and eventually to some traffic lights at a T junction.

Turn left onto St Andrews street before turning almost immediately right onto Duke Street where the St Andrews Multi-Storey Car Park is situated.

Once you've found a space, exit the car park onto St Andrews, turning left and following the road until you see our logo on a building about 250 yards on your left. There's a great coffee and savoury/sweet shop called Espresso opposite us so if you're a little early and peckish that's the place we recommend for your refreshments.

FROM THE WEST AND THE NORTH

Travelling East towards Norwich on the A47, turn off on the slip road signposted "Norwich" and "A11" and then follow the above directions from "Newmarket Road".

WALKING FROM TRAIN STATION

Leave the Train station car park from the pedestrian exit opposite the entrance to the main building. Cross the road and go over the bridge almost directly in front of you (passing The Nelson hotel on the left hand side).

This road forks left, continue walking on the right hand side fork, so the traffic is oncoming. Use one of the pedestrian crossings along Prince of Wales road and then at the top of this hill, follow the pavement around to the right onto Upper King Street.

Walk slightly down hill, passing two roads on the left, taking the third left into the cobbled Princes Street. If you follow this to the end you will see a small courtyard with some wooden benches and an Irish Bar. Our office is behind you to your left – you'll see our logo on our building.
